

POKER GAME RULES & REGULATIONS

Spread around the field will be cards, find them and put them together any way you can to make poker hands. Make as many hands as possible, be sure to try and make high value hands in order to get the best points value you can. The player with the most points from the poker game at the end of the game will receive a free field fee and one case of paint. The next five runners up will receive one free field fee each (includes entry, rental, and all day air no paint included.)

HANDS & POINT VALUES

Royal Flush -10 points

Any five consecutive cards of the same suit going from ten to ace

Straight Flush- 9 points

Any five consecutive cards of the same suit

Four of a Kind- 8 points

Any four cards of the same card value

Full House- 7 points

Any three cards of the same value plus any two cards of the same value

Flush- 6 points

Any five cards of the same suit (not consecutive).

Straight- 5 points

Any five consecutive cards of different suits.

Three of a Kind- 4 points

Any three cards of the same value.

Two Pair- 3 points

Any two cards of the same value plus another two cards of the same value.

One Pair- 1 points

Any two cards of the same value.

Aces may be high or low and players do not need to turn in full five card hands unless turning in a set that requires five cards to be complete.
